**EMISSION CONSENT ORDER**

With reference to the application dated **03.09.2012** of **M/S M.P. Chini Industries Ltd, Manjhaulia, West Champaran** for consent under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, he/they is/are granted consent to operate his/their plant at **Manjhaulia, West Champaran** for the period from **01.10.2012 to 30.09.2015** with the following conditions:-

1. That, he/they shall not make any alteration, addition, deletion or modification in the plant without the prior clearance from the Board and shall also abide by the obligations under sections 22,23 and 31A of the Air(Prevention & Control of Pollution ) Act,1981 and further shall extend co-operation to the Board in performing its functions entrusted under sections 24,25 and 26 of the Act ;
2. That, he /they shall comply with the requirements of rule 14 of the Environment(Protection) Rules, 1986; rules 4,5,7,9,10 and 11 of the Hazardous Wastes (Management and Handling), Rules 1989; rules 4,5,7,8,10,11,12,13,15,17 and 18 of the Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemical Rules,1989; and the provisions of the Public Liability Insurance Act,1991,whichever is applicable;
3. That, he/they shall monitor his/their emission(s) and the ambient air quality from representative point regularly and shall maintain its quality in conformity with Board's standards and shall produce its proof, as and when asked for;
4. That, he/they shall submit application for consent 30 days before the expiration of the period of consent i.e. **31.08.2015** or within 30 days from the date of receipt of this order, whichever is applicable.
5. That, the unit shall operate wet scrubber regularly and emission of particulate matter from the stack shall be less than **150 mg/NH<sup>3</sup>** and the plant shall not be operated in any case when Air Pollution Control device is not under operation.
6. That, the unit shall submit flue gas analysis report of all stacks within the consent period.
7. That, the unit shall submit AAQ report to the Board within the consent period.
8. That, the unit shall submit Environmental Statement annually to the Board.
9. That, solid wastes shall be stored and disposed off properly to avoid any nuisance inside and around the plant campus.
10. That, tree plantation shall be done all around the campus and open land shall be kept maintained.
11. That, the house keeping of the Mill area and the approach road around the mill shall be maintained properly.

**DISCHARGE CONSENT ORDER**

With reference to the application dated **03.09.2012** of **M/S M.P. Chini Industries Ltd, P.O. Manjhaulia, Dist. Bettiah, (West Champaran)** under section 25/ 26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, he/they is/are granted consent to bring into use his/their new/altered/existing outlet(s) for discharge of trade effluent and/or domestic sewage at **P.O. Manjhaulia, Dist. Bettiah, (West Champaran)** for the period from **01.10.2012** to **30.09.2015** subject to the following conditions:-

1. That, he/they shall not make any alteration, addition, deletion or modification in the plant without the prior Clearance from the Board and shall also abide by the obligations under sections 24,31 and 33A of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and further shall extend co-operation to the Board in performing its functions entrusted under sections 20,21,23,30 and 32 of the Act;
2. That, he/they shall comply with the requirements of rule 14 of the Environment(Protection)Rules,1986; rules 4,5,7,9,10,11 of the Hazardous Wastes(Management and Handling)Rules 1989, rules 4,5,7,8,10,11,12,13,15 and 18 of the Manufacture storage and Import of Hazardous Chemical Rules, 1989; and the provisions of Public Liability Insurance act,1991, whichever is applicable;
3. That, he/they shall monitor his/her effluent(s) regularly and maintain its quality in conformity with Board's standards and shall produce its proof, as and when asked for;
4. That, he/they shall submit application for consent again 30 days before the expiration of the period of consent i.e **30.11.2015** or within 30days from the date of receipt of this order whichever is applicable.
5. **That, the unit shall upload the monitoring data and compliance report of Environmental Clearance conditions on its website within one month.**
6. **That, the rain water harvesting system shall be adopted within one month.**
7. **That, the unit shall submit raw and treated effluent analysis report monthly to the Board.**
8. **That, after treatment the unit shall reuse of its total effluent and there shall be no discharge out side of the campus in any case.**
9. **That, the unit shall operate its ETP regularly during operation of the plant and in the connection the unit shall maintain a log book.**
10. **That, they shall submit Environmental Statement annually to the Board.**
11. **That, if the unit fails to comply the above mentioned conditions within the stipulated period then consent order shall be revoked.**

FORM FOR GRANT/RENEWAL OF AUTHORIZATION BY SPCB/PCC FOR OCCUPIERS, REPROCESSERS, REUSERS AND OPERATORS OF FACILITIES FOR COLLECTION, RECEPTION, TREATMENT STORAGE, TRANSPORT AND DISPOSAL OF HAZARDOUS WASTE.

1. Number of authorization and date of issue P/T-4-027/12 *10-15-21-27-12-12*
2. **M/s Jay Shree Sugar Mill** is hereby granted an authorization to operate a facility for collection, storage, recycling and offering for sale of hazardous waste in the premises situated at **Majhauria, West Champaran.**
3. The authorization granted to operate a facility for generation, collection, storage, transport and offering for sale of hazardous wastes (Used/ Spent Oil) and Skimmed oil & grease.
4. The authorisation shall be in force for a period of five years from **17.12.2012 to 16.12.2017.**
5. The authorization is subject to the conditions stated below and to such conditions as may be specified in the rules for the time being in force under the environment (protection) Act, 1986.

### TERMS AND CONDITONS OF AUTHORISATION

1. The authorization shall comply with the provisions of the environment (protection) Act, 1986 and rules made there under.
2. The authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorized by the Bihar State Pollution Control Board.
3. The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the hazardous wastes without prior permission at the State Pollution Control Board.
4. Any unauthorized change in personnel, equipment as working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of his authorization.
5. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the State Pollution Control Board to close down the facility.
6. An application for the renewal of an authorisation shall be made as laid under these rules.
7. The unit shall store its hazardous waste (Used/ Spent Oil, HW category no. 5.1 and Skimmed oil & grease, HW category no. 3.4.4) for a temporary period in the premises for the purpose of its **reuse and sale to authorized recycler**, if it meets the specification laid down in part A of schedule-V of the Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling & Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2008.
8. They shall maintain record of Generation, Storage and sale of hazardous waste in Form-3 and submit the annual return containing the details specified in Form-4 on or before the 30th day of June of the financial year.
9. They shall store the hazardous waste in such a manner to avoid contamination with rain water and ground water.
10. The unit shall submit the analysis report of hazardous waste (used oil).
